### Pumpkin Chocolate Chip Cookies

Linda Gallagher family recipe



- 2 cups cooked pumpkin
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 cup Crisco oil
- 2 eggs
- 1 Tbs vanilla
- 2 tsp baking soda dissolved in 2 tsp milk
- 4 cups flour
- 4 tsp baking powder
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 2 cups chocolate chips

Preheat oven to 350°. In a bowl combine flour, powder, cinnamon & salt and set aside. In a stand mixer add your pumpkin, sugar, oil, eggs, vanilla & baking soda/milk and mix until combined. Add bowl of dry ingredients and mix well. Add chocolate chips. Scoop onto parchment lined cookie sheet and bake 12-13 minutes.

Makes approximately 3 dozen.

### **Tent** (available Mon-Sun 10am-6pm; May-Oct)

- \$100 an hour
- A \$100 refundable security deposit is required 30 days prior to your event
- 8' banquet tables & white chairs (maximum seating/occupancy 150 guests)
- Ladies & Gents Bathroom Facility with handicap access
- On-site parking
- No smoking permitted inside tent.
- No loud music, fireworks or explosive devices

### **Pavilion** (available Mon-Sun 10am-6pm; May-Oct)

- \$25 an hour
- A \$50 refundable security deposit is required 30 days prior to your event
- Overhead lighting and electrical outlets
- Small enclosed kitchen area with counter space, sink and refrigerator/freezer
- Tables & Chairs (max seating/occupancy 60)
- Bathroom facilities are inside the Market
- Parking permitted directly in front of the pavilion on paved lot
- No smoking permitted in the pavilion or the playground
- No loud music. We must be respectful of any events happening at our tent and to our Market/Greenhouse customers

### **Cafe** (available Mon-Sun 5-8pm; year round)

- \$50 an hour
- A \$100 refundable security deposit is required 30 days prior to your event
- Tables & Chairs (max seating/occupancy 50 guests)
- Bathroom facility inside the Market
